



Individual Information Profile (IIP) Data Results Fiscal Year 2010-2015 Affiliate: Gunnison Valley Mentors

This document reflects findings from the Individual Information Profile (IIP). OMNI has provided these findings so that the Partners Mentoring Association (PMA) affiliates can better understand their program's progress.

The findings summarize results from the IIPs that were administered during the 2010-11 fiscal year through the 2014-15 fiscal year (FY). Please note that if a youth completed multiple IIPs within the same fiscal year, the most recently completed IIP was included based on the PMA evaluation committee's recommendation that the IIP be collected at post-test within the same fiscal year starting July 1, 2014 since more information is learned from youth and their family after a year of establishing rapport and trust. In addition, for FY 2010-11 through FY 2013-14, if a youth completed multiple IIPs during different fiscal years, only the first (i.e., least recent) IIP was included in analyses, as it was assumed the more recent IIP was administered to a youth who was re-matched with a new mentor. For FY 2014-15, the PMA evaluation committee requested that the analysis process be changed so that data for re-matched youth is not excluded from analyses. Thus, if a youth had an IIP for FY 2014-15 as well as for a previous year, both IIPs were included in analyses.

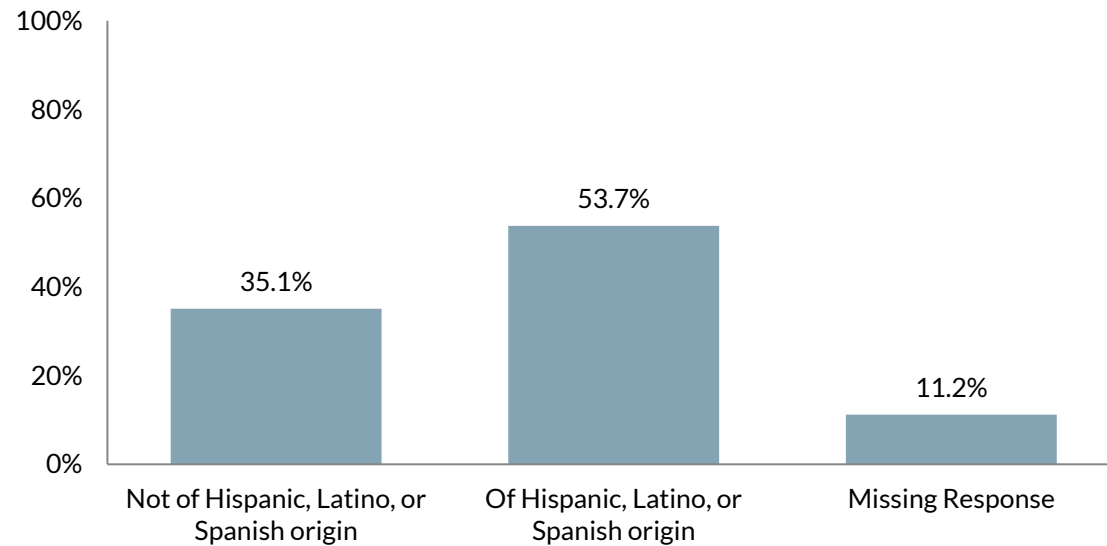
Please also note that several versions of the IIP were administered between and within years. Findings presented in this document reflect the questions that appear in the majority of versions to allow for a cumulative analysis of the IIPs collected across years.

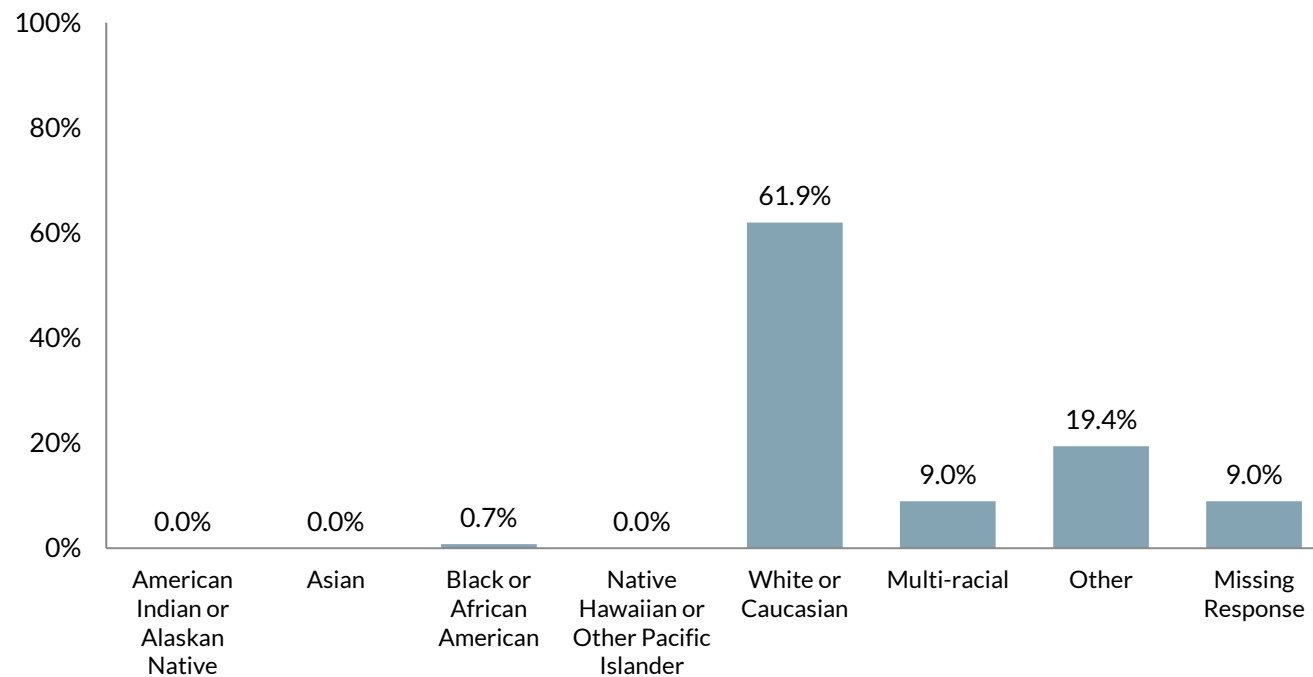

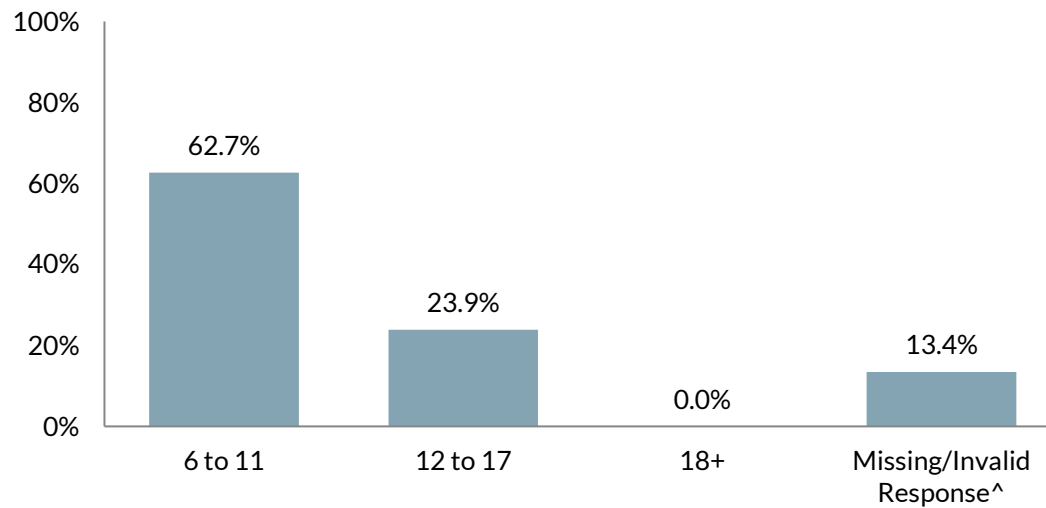

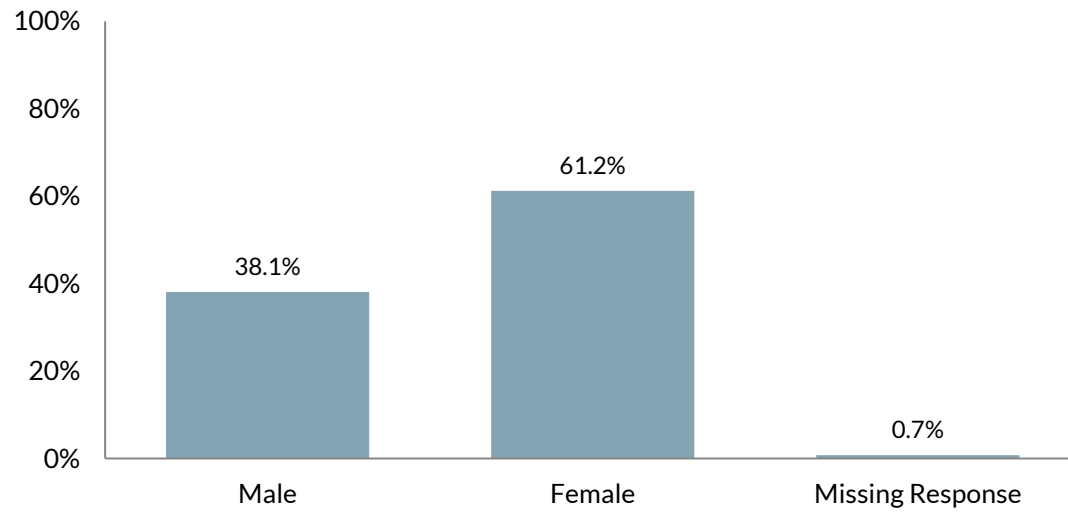

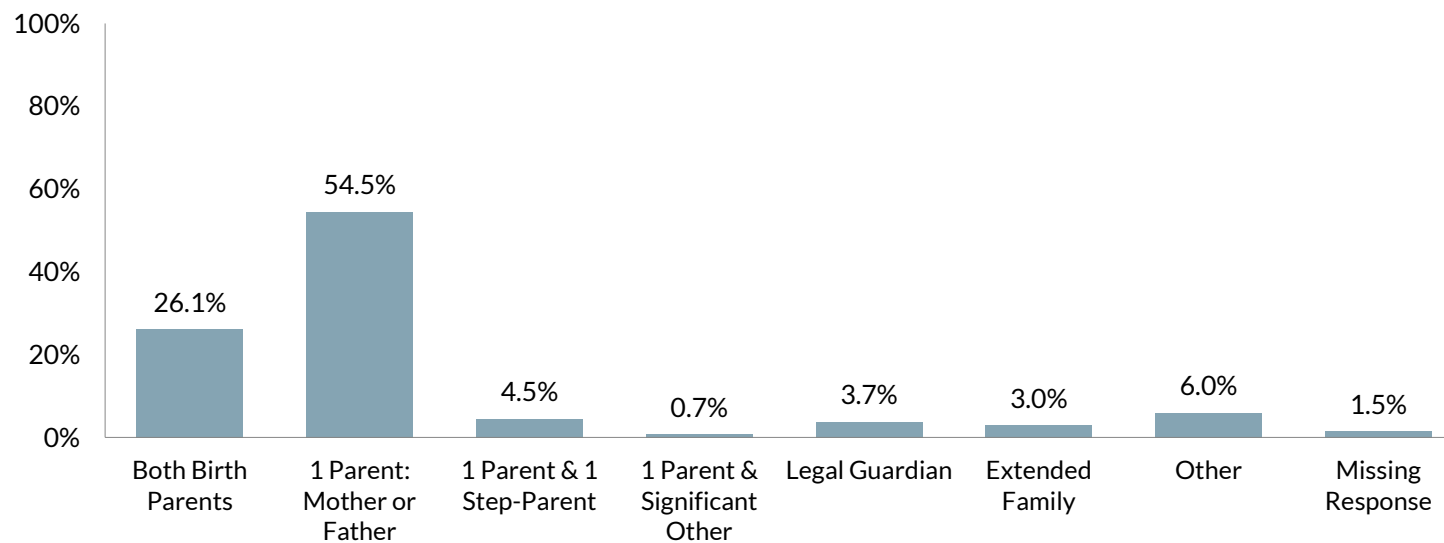

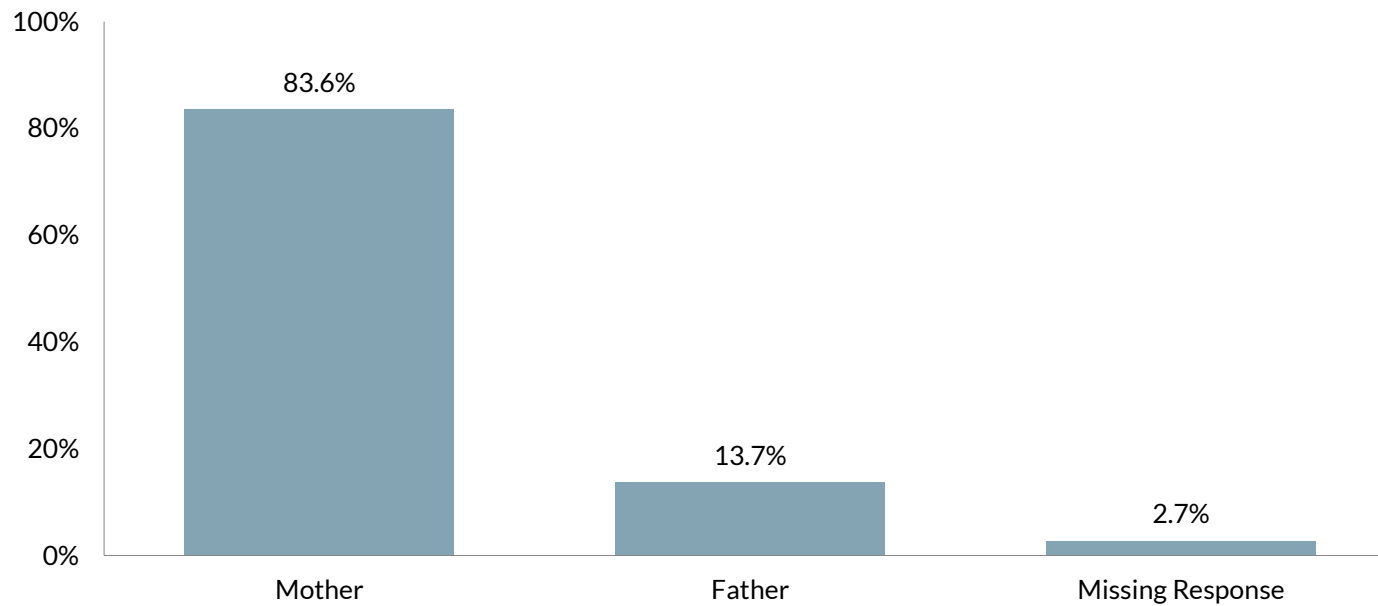

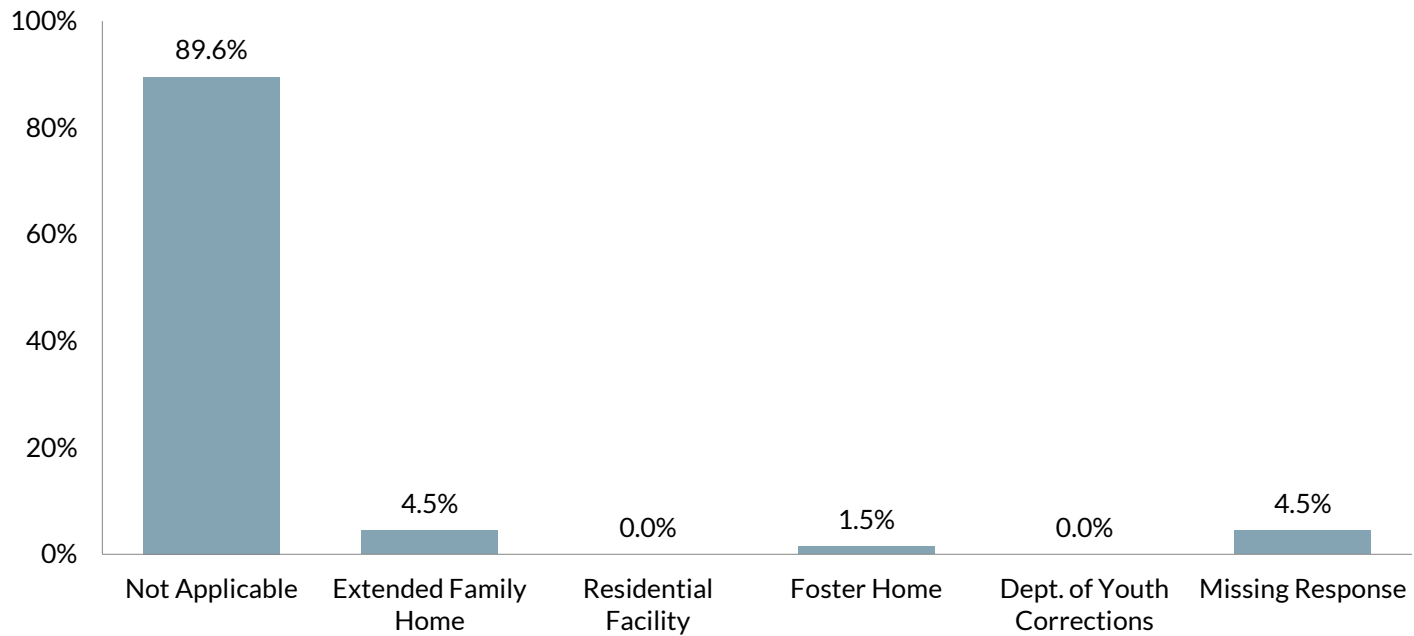

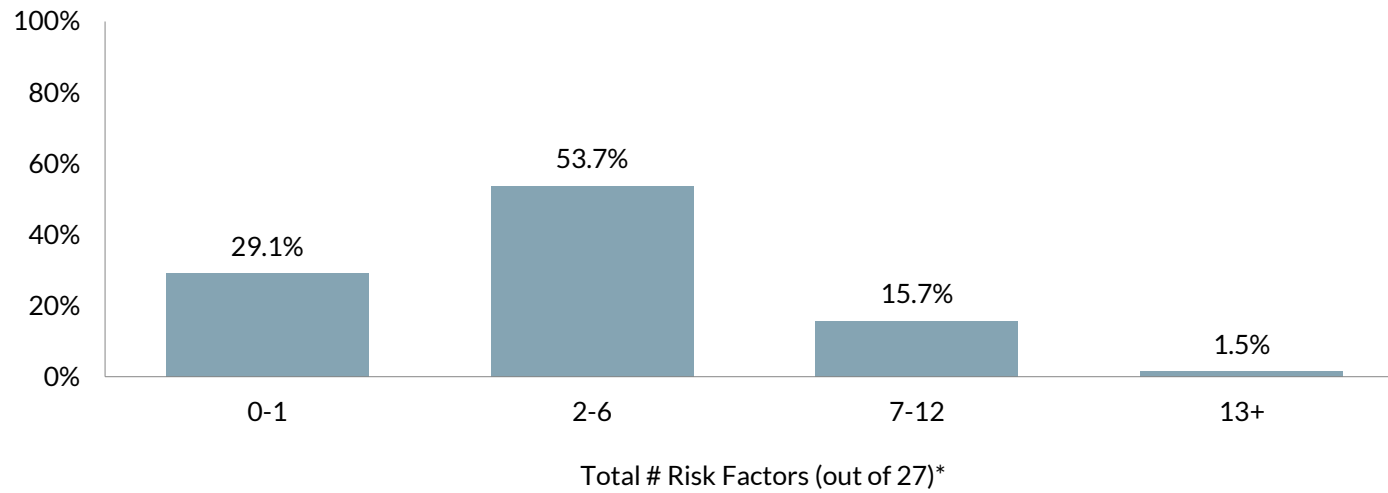
